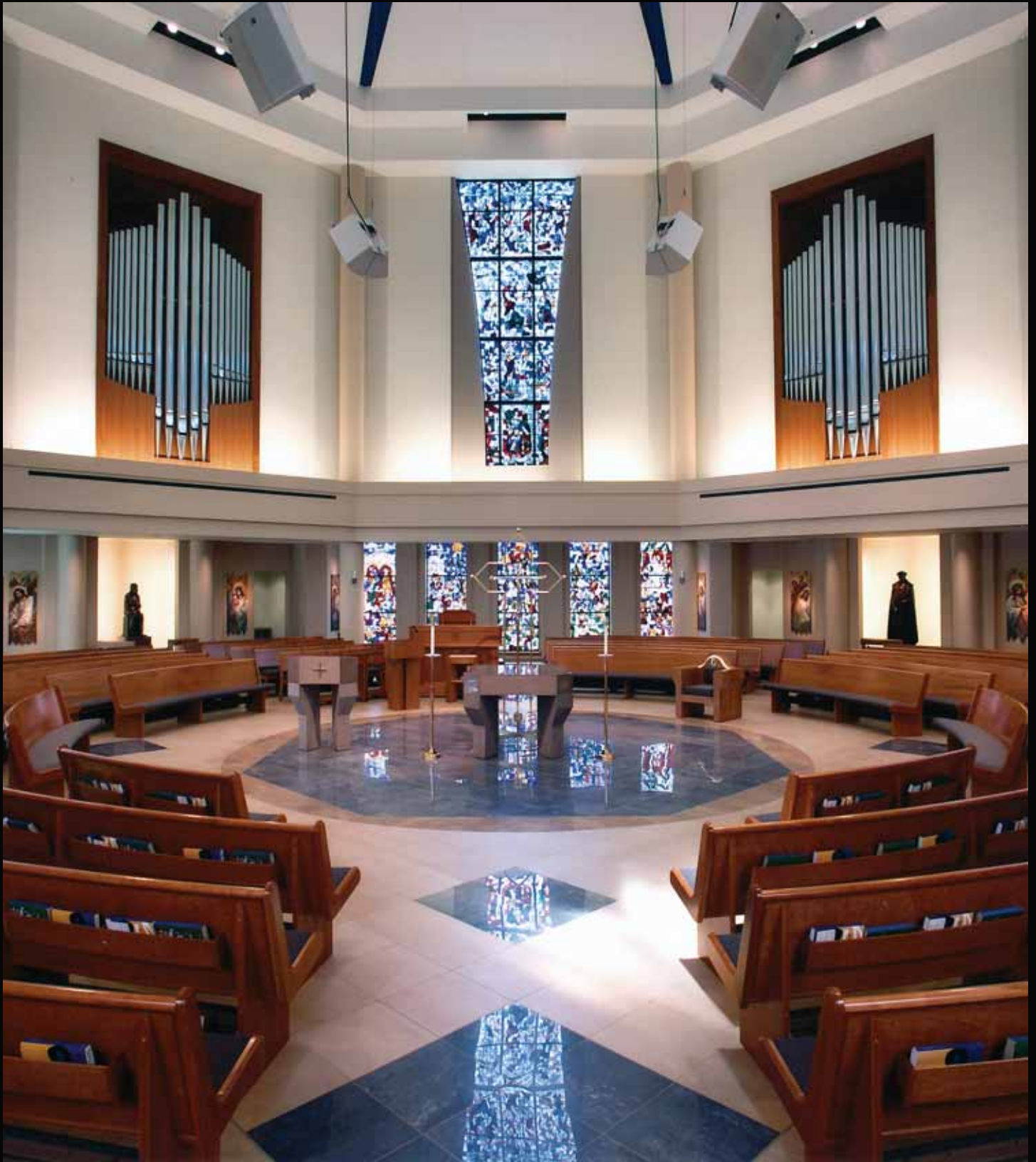

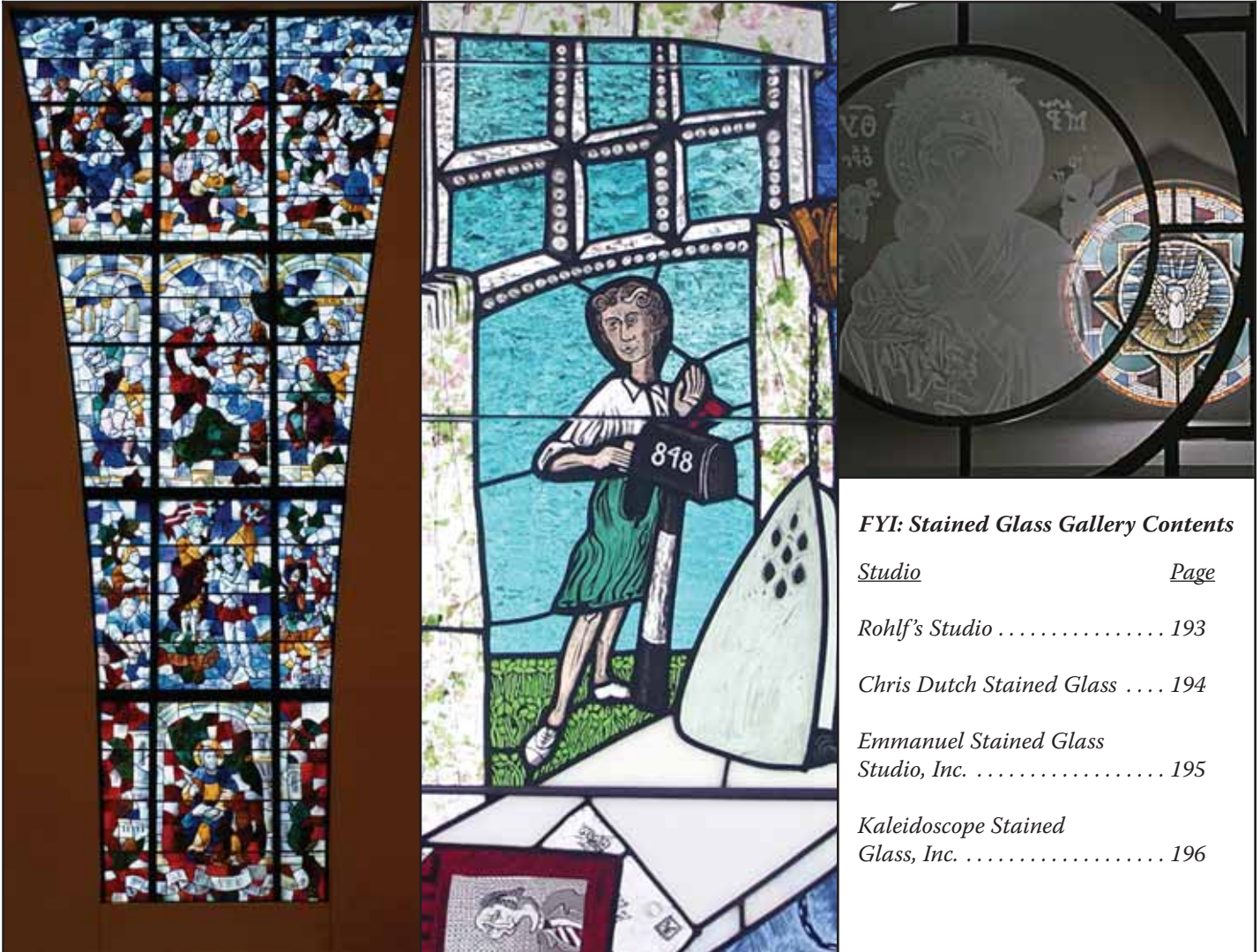

All of the works were coordinated, fabricated and installed by Rohlf's Studio. The project, originally scheduled for two and a half years, was completed four months early.

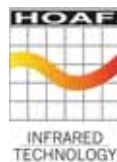
