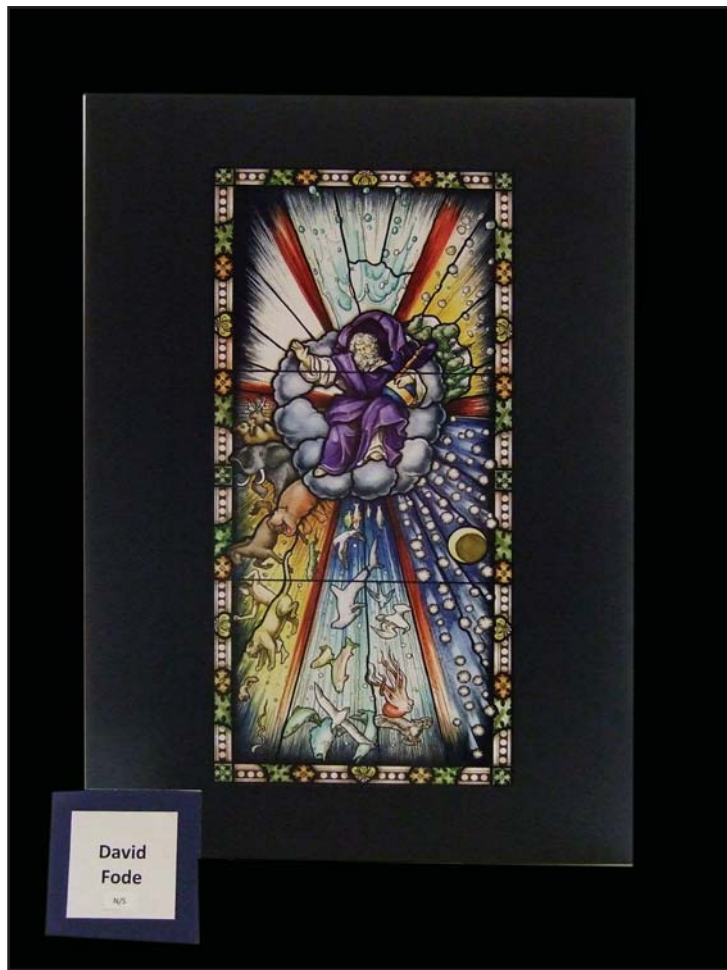

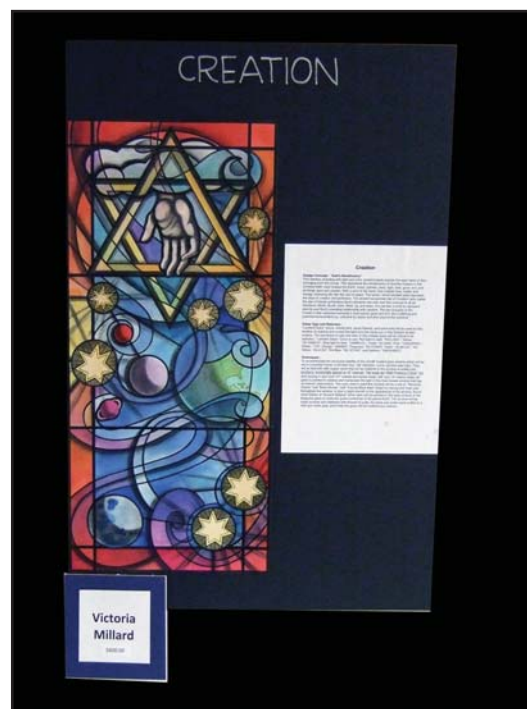

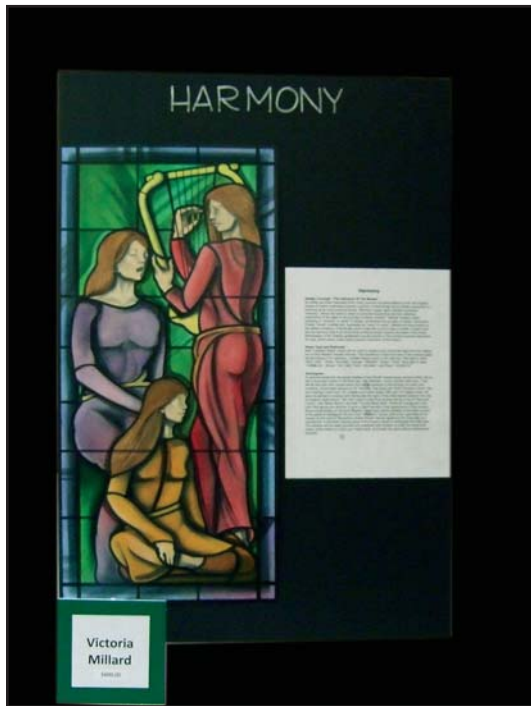
David Fode, Winner of Popular Vote; also, Creation, Third Place



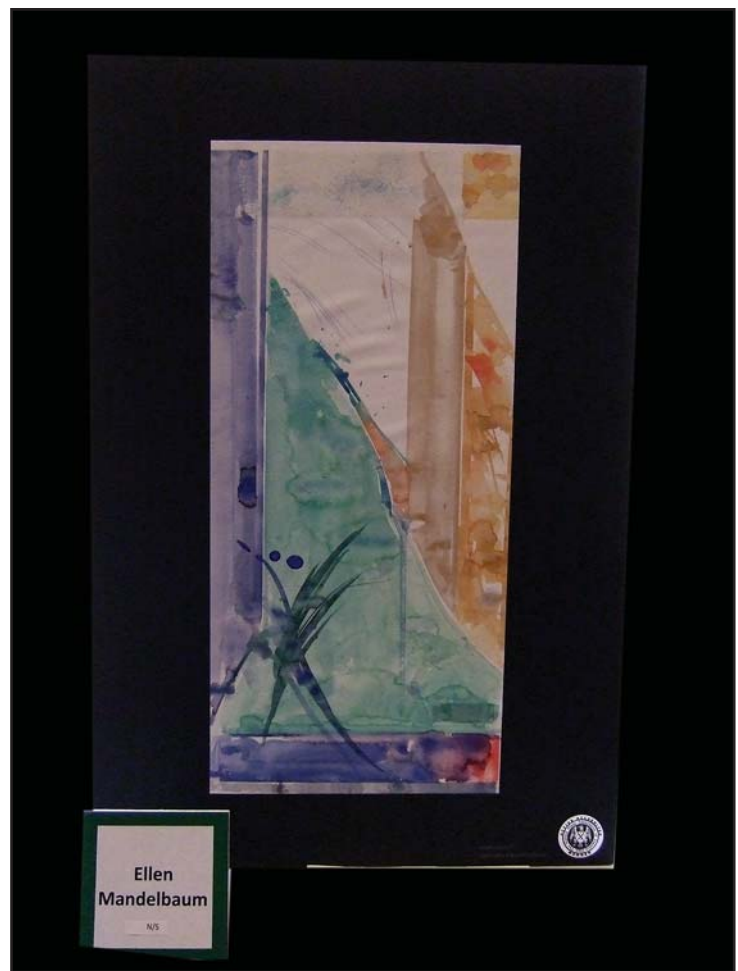
Diane Eissinger, Creation, First Place



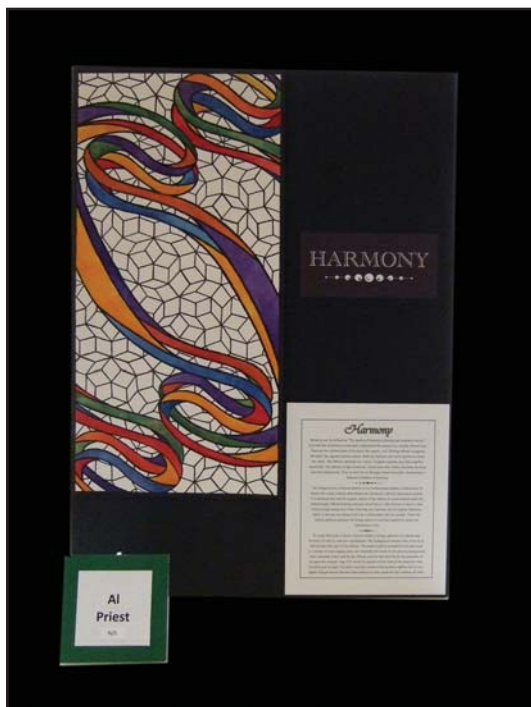
Victoria Millard, Creation, Second Place
